

British Cycling needs new Ride Leaders to help encourage more cycling for fun.

Do you love recreational cycling? Do you want to help get your community on a bike?

Would you like to get a British Cycling qualification and lead Sky Ride Local guided rides?

Sky Ride Local is all about bringing bike rides to local people, using routes planned by local people.

We're looking for confident recreational cyclists to train as Ride Leaders and Route Planners. You don't need to be an expert or super-fast, just have reasonable fitness and be confident riding in a group. Our Ride Leaders are friendly, enthusiastic, chatty people who love encouraging others and are happy to work as part of a team.

The assessed one-day course qualifies you to deliver guided rides for groups of beginner- and intermediate-level adults, and accompanied children, on roads and paths. A smaller number can go on to take the additional Route Planner training course.

In addition to free training, we'll provide you with branded kit, British Cycling Ride membership, payment for leading and assisting on rides, and access to other goodies. In return, we expect Ride Leaders to be flexible with their weekend availability, to commit to leading on a minimum of four weekends during 2014, and to use their qualification to run informal social rides in the community at other times.

On the Sky Ride Local programme, Ride Leaders work as part of a team, guiding rides together on a set route and at a set time specified by British Cycling (the majority of rides take place on Sundays).
